Nominations must reach the Returning Officer via the lodgement method(s) stipulated below **not later than 5:00pm AWST on 20/08/2019**.

PLEASE NOTE:

2. In order to be able to be received by the AEC, emails (including attachments) should be no greater than 6 MB in size.

Withdrawing Nominations

Nominations cannot be withdrawn after 5:00pm AWST on 20/08/2019.

Voting Period

If require a ballot will be conducted 10/09/2019 – 12:00noon AWST 01/10/2019

Scrutineers

The appointment of scrutineers opens 06/08/2019 and closes on 01/10/2019.

Candidates for election to any office shall be notified by the Returning Officer when the issue of ballot papers take place, and when and where the count of ballot papers shall take place, in order that they may attend to check the same.

The ballot box shall locked and sealed in the presence of at least two scrutineers, and shall not be opened until after the ballot closes, and then only in the presence of scrutineers.

Each candidate shall, when nominating for a position, appoint a scrutineer to represent him at the counting of the ballot, such scrutineer to be a financial member of the Union. If the Returning Officer reports to the Committee of Management that a candidate has failed to make such an appointment, the Committee of Management shall do so.

A form is available from the Returning Officer for the purposes of appointing Scrutineers.
